Dear Parents and Carers

- Entertainment from our Sixth Form Band in the Study Plus room, located next to the Dining Hall

We ask that students sign in at either the main school reception or the dining hall using the QR Code provided in these areas at the start of the evening. On the night of the event, a booklet will be distributed, providing a map of the subject marketplace, details of the application process, and subject requirements. Additionally, the Sixth Form prospectus and handbook will be available online on the same day.



Applications to Sixth Form can be made from Monday 25th November and need to be submitted online via the school website. The link will be provided closer to the date. Please ensure your application is submitted by Friday 10th January 2025. While we will consider late applications, the subjects we offer will be based on the first phase of applications.
