Dear Parents and Carers

Firstly, I would like to share my deepest thanks to our students, staff body and parents for their valuable input into the Ofsted inspection that took place over Tuesday and Wednesday this week. The two-day inspection looked at all aspects of the school's provision and identified many areas of strength as well as areas for continued development. The process of quality assurance means that the outcome of the inspection is currently confidential. The timeline is that the final report will be published within 30 working days of the conclusion of the inspection. It is at that point that I will share the report with you all, thank you for your patience.

Homework Review

Thank you for the responses to the Homework Review that was sent out earlier this year. Common procedural themes that were raised have been fed back to Faculty teams for them to consider in their setting.

Some of these were:

- Ensuring that homework is set on the stated day for each year group
- Ensuring all homework is set as a task rather than an announcement
- Plenty of notice for upcoming tests

Heads of Faculty will be meeting in a few weeks, when we will be discussing the issues raised around the types of tasks set, how feedback is given to students on homework and the length of time that tasks should take for each year group.

The current system of setting homework on one day, with a maximum of a two-week deadline has been positively received in the main, though we recognise no one system will ever be ideal for all students. If not already flagged in the survey or with your child's tutor, please do continue to contact your child's tutor in the first instance with any issues specific to your child around the completion of homework.

Parents of Sixth Form students

If your child is driving to school, could you please discuss with them the key points we have raised in assemblies with them, and our key expectations:

We have had concerns raised by our neighbours in recent weeks and would really appreciate us all coming together as the wider school community to ensure that Sixth Form students consider the implications of their choices on the community.

Students were updated about a month of awareness initiatives being run by the local community and how to share any concerns or to seek support.
