As you are aware, at the end of April, Gordano School welcomed Ofsted inspectors into school as part of a routine Section 5 inspection. Before this, the school had not been inspected since 2012, which was under the previous inspection framework.

I am proud to now share with you the final report, which is a testament to the wonderful young people in our school and the dedication of our staff body in ensuring that we provide a high-quality education for our students at all stages.

Ofsted has deemed our school Good in all areas of the framework. The report highlights many areas of the school where our strengths were evident, including a well-constructed curriculum from Year 7 through to our sixth form provision which allows students to study a breadth of subjects enabling our young people to build on their prior knowledge securely. The report highlights the positive and courteous relationships that students have with their staff who provide effective support for our students.
