

- Largest year group for some years! (190)









Expectations, Attendance and punctuality

"Study Plus" and free periods


- Study Plus are lessons where a register is taken but is used for private study. These lessons take place in the Year 12 Study Room.




The government grants some students who are in financial need a bursary.
