## Year 12 Update

Year 12 have been very busy over the last few weeks. On Friday 21st June Emma, Student Leader for the Arts, promoted World Music Day by focusing on music in schools and the charity *Preludes* by planning the tutor lesson discussion on the value of music in our lives and schools. She also hosted a bake sale in the Sixth Form Common Room which raised over £80 for Preludes. Preludes is a Bristol based charity working to promote and bring more music into state schools in the area.

## Concerns raised by neighbours of Portishead Town Football Club

Residents have reported anti-social behaviour concerns during or following the England games. Their concerns relate to Secondary school aged children's use of alcohol, vapes and also general abusive behaviour. Some residents have had items thrown into their garden from the football club side, which has caused damage to items in their gardens. In some cases, items have also been taken from gardens. In addition to this, staff from the football club have also encountered verbal abuse when challenging children. As parents/carers please can you speak with your child if they have been going to the football club to watch the games to ensure that they are not involved in such behaviour. This should be a time when the whole community comes together to positively support the England team and incidents such as this should not be happening.

## Gate Incident - Risk Assessment Update from September 2024 and changes for Years 7 & 8

Following on from our visit with the Health and Safety Executive and the investigation undertaken from our competent advisor we will be continuing with appropriate updates to our risk assessment as well as implementing the following recommendations from **September 2024** (when again we have a full school of students). This is paramount from a Health and Safety perspective and to ensure that we are doing everything to prioritise the safety of all students when leaving the school site.

- 1. September INSET full briefing with all staff including new staff to ensure full training completed with regards to management of the school gate and emergency procedures
- 2. Hi-Vis vests and whistles given to all new staff required in an emergency where command and control of a situation is required (this has already been provided to current staff)
- 3. Permanent additional supervision at the end of the school day (as we have in place now)
- 4. All SLT members have gate keys (as we have in place now)

- 5. Emergency protocol training through all expectations assemblies for each Year Group in September - including directions for all cyclists regarding the delineation between pedestrian gates and gates which can be cycled through
- 6. From September 2024 with a full school (Year 11 and Year 13 have not been on site for the majority of Term 5 and 6 at the end of the school day) we will, for Health and Safety reasons, be introducing an end of school stagger. This means that students in Years 7 and 8 will leave school 5 minutes earlier than everyone else every day. As such please see the change to the new timings of the school day below.

#### Year 8 Learning Groups from September 2024

As we come to the end of the academic year, I would like to congratulate all our Year 7 students on their successful first year at Gordano. They have recently passed the milestone of receiving over 200,000 merits as a year group and they have made excellent progress on the new Gordano curriculum. When students return after the summer holidays and join Year 8, they will no longer be taught in tutor groups, but instead will be placed in different learning groups from across the year group. Students will still retain their tutor group and House identity and will be together for registration and tutor time, but in lessons they will start to mix with a wider range of students. We will put together new learning groups again when the students reach Year 9 in September 2025.

#### **Aspens Catering**

We have continued to develop our working relationship with Aspens and have been building on the feedback from the survey so many of you completed at the start of January. Below is an image showing the presentation of food in the main dining hall, including a selection of salad pots as a direct response to student and parent requests in that survey. We have asked Aspens to provide more information on the dietary content of meals and better marketing info so that we can help promote the developments with students and parents.

There are new menus being launched in September and details of these will be posted on the Dining page of the school website. Please have a look and discuss these with your children.

The biggest development for September will be the removal of carton drinks from the offer. This means that all students will need a drinks bottle to use at either the free water fountains located around the school site, or the sustainable drinks dispensers in the dining hall and canteen.
