As we move into the final week of term, we have a range of festive activities ahead which we are all looking forward to. Year 7 Charity Week

Next week will see fun activities every day for Year 7s during their charity week supporting 'Be More Ben' and the 'British Heart Foundation' charities:

Phone-Free School

On Wednesday 11th December, I had the pleasure of visiting Redmaids School in Bristol with two members of my senior team; Redmaids began using the Yondr system in September.



We had the opportunity to meet with staff and pupils, who talked to us about their transition to using Yondr pouches and the impact it has had on school life and their phone habits. Whilst Redmaids is in a different context to us, the conversations we had around phone habits and mental health echoed those we have had in school with our young people. The visit has confirmed the significant importance of our upcoming move to using the Yondr system and helped to shape our thinking about the launch of it.

Many of you will have already seen the Channel 4 documentary, that also aired on Wednesday 11th December, 'Swiped: The School that Banned Smartphones', but for those who haven't, we would recommend watching it. It is an uncomfortable watch for anyone involved in raising young people, staff and parents alike, but is very helpful for all of us in considering how we support young people with safe and healthy engagement in the online world.

Year 10AR1 Reports and Target setting

We are working with a new system of reporting with Year 10, moving to fine grading. As you will be aware, Year 10 students do not have KS2 data from Primary School, due to the disruption from the pandemic. As a result, we have used MIDYIS testing to produce their target grades. There can be anomalies for some subjects placing a lower target grade than the projected grade. This will be monitored and rectified moving forward to represent more accurate targets, so please use the projected grade as a measure of progress at the moment. Thank you for your understanding.

Mock Exams

Well done to Year 11 (and Year 10 Religious Studies students) who have demonstrated exceptional commitment and focus in their approach towards the mock examinations. Students have been a credit to themselves, and I have received lots of positive feedback about the students. Some subjects may be able to share feedback with students and offer scores. However, the Mock Result Grades will be shared on <u>Friday 17 January</u>, where students will be able to collect them from the Main Hall at the start of the school day.
